- If you claim points for entering adult levels, boys must have shot a York or Gents FITA and girls must have shot a Hereford or Ladies FITA
- At team tournaments only entry points can be claimed
- If you claim adult result points your position must be from the adult list. i.e. If you claim 1st place you must have beaten everyone! Indoor tournaments are the same. You claim points for the section entered e.g. at a Regional Championship a girl must beat every lady to take 100 points – otherwise it's 20 points for being first in her Junior section.

3. Handicap Improvement

Starting Handicap: Experienced archers – put your handicap on 1 January, based in your best three outdoor scores from the previous year.
