PERSONAL ARCHERY CHALLENGES

OUTDOOR CLASSIFICATION BADGES

Outdoor Classification

- A badge is awarded to the Jolly Archer when the qualifying level is achieved for the first time.
- The badges awarded by the club are Bowmen, 1st Class, 2nd Class, 3rd Class
- Master Bowman and Grand Master Bowman are awarded by ArcheryGB
- Classification badges are available for Gentlemen, U18 Gentlemen, U16 Gentlemen, U14 Gentlemen, U12 Gentlemen, Ladies, U18 Ladies, U16 Ladies, U14 Ladies, and U12 Ladies.
- The eligible bow types are Recurve, Compound, Longbow, and Recurve Barebow.
- The qualifying period is a year from January 1st to December 31st
- Three appropriate rounds need to be shot in the current season to qualify.
- The eligible rounds for each badge differ for age and gender and require certain distances and a certain number of arrows. More arrows and longer distances as the standard required increases.
- Details of appropriate rounds and the scores required can be found in the Rules of Shooting under Archery GB Shooting Administrative Procedures section 7 Classification Scheme. This can be found on the Archery GB website, or under the Archery GB icon in “Members Pages” on the Jollys website, or in the Archery GB “Rules of Shooting” binder copies of which are in the clubhouse and boss container at Jubilee Park.
- Badges are awarded during the summer season as the qualification is achieved.
- The progress of current members towards Classification achievements can be found on the Jollys website in Members Pages and on the Noticeboard at Jubilee Park
