Conditions of Entry:

1. Archery GB membership cards must be produced if requested.

2. The organiser reserves the right to modify the target lists on the day.

3. This is a record status shoot. Liability to drug testing applies. Competitors approached to give samples must comply, as refusal will be treated as a positive result.

4. Archery GB dress regulations will apply (Rule 307)

5. Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements or hearing impairment you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested, if possible, to arrange for an agent to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please let the organiser know.

6. General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), Please note that when you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

7. In line with the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anybody wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival and provide proof of identity. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.

8. Liability - Although every reasonable attempt will be made to ensure archers have an enjoyable visit to our venue, Jolly Archers cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained whilst competing in or attending this event. Archery GB insurance cover is in place.

9. Please note that Judges will now inspect archers' equipment at all UK record status events

10. Animals, other than assistance animals such as guide dogs are not permitted.

11. Ample parking is available. These with limited mobility should contact the organiser in advance to discuss parking options.

12. Lost arrows should be reported to a judge or a member of the field party. Please remember to inform them should you subsequently find the arrow.

13. Age Groups - Men, Women, Under 18 Men, Under 18 Women, Under 16 Men, Under 16 Women, Under 15 Men, Under 15 Women, Under 14 Men, Under 14 Women, Under 12 men and Under 12 Women. We are not including the Under 21 or 50+ age groups for this year's shoot but will be collecting data from the entry forms to inform future decisions on these groups.

Please Note: An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category e.g., if they turned 17 in a year, they can complete in an U18 category but they cannot turn 18 in that year.
