PERSONAL ARCHERY CHALLENGES

“252” Improvement Award Scheme

General

The aim of the scheme is to provide an incentive to improve an archer's skill when shooting outdoors.

Rules for awarding badges

1. Archery GB rules of shooting are to apply.
2. Arrows to be shot at the specified distance using a 122cm face and Archery GB 5 zone scoring.
3. Six sighters are permitted which will not count towards the final score, followed by 36 arrows for all bow types.
4. The three dozen arrows may be shot as a “252” round or as the first three dozen of a longer Imperial round.
5. Distances, with associated badges, are 20yds, 30yds, 40yds, 50yds, 60yds, 80yds and 100yds.
6. You can only claim one “252 badge” per day.
7. Badges must be claimed in sequence i.e. 20yds, 30yds, 40yds, etc.
8. Scores need to be achieved twice to qualify for the award.
9. Only one badge will be awarded even if a qualifying score is shot with several bow types.
10. If shot at the start of a longer round, please mark “252” and the distance attempted on the score sheet.
11. It is the responsibility of the archer concerned to make a claim with the score sheet witnessed by one other person and correctly filled in and signed.
12. The claim should be presented to the Records Officer who will be responsible for verifying the claim.
13. Badges will be presented as soon as possible after the required score has been achieved.
14. Score required:
