Rounds:	Portsmouth and Double Portsmouth rounds shot on foam bosses. Compounds will shoot on individual 3-spot vertical faces. Other bow types on single spot faces unless requested otherwise.							
	Please note: To allow more archers to shoot, preference will be given to archers requesting single or double rounds. Triple rounds will only be allocated after the closing date if space permits . Any archer wishing to shoot three Portsmouth rounds should clearly indicate on the entry form which of the sessions would be their third choice. Payment for the third session should not be made until after a place has been confirmed.							
Age Groups	50+ Men, 50+ Women, Men, Women, U18 Men, U18 Women, U15 Men and U15 Women – See Para 10 in Conditions of Entry.							
Entry Fee:	£12.00 per session. Places will not be reserved without payment.							
Shooting Rules:	AGB rules in place at the time of the shoot will be applied.

	Longbow Club Team, Recurve Barebow Club Team and Compound Club Team - Two highest scoring archers from a club in each bow type.

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Conditions of Entry:

- 1. Payment of entry fee(s) must be within 7 days of the receipt of the entry form. If not received, the entry may be cancelled.
- 2. Archery GB membership cards must be produced at registration.
- 3. The organiser reserves the right to modify the target lists on the day.
- 4. This is a record status shoot. Liability to drug testing applies. Competitors approached to give samples must comply, as refusal will be treated as a positive result.
- 5. Archery GB dress regulations will apply (Rule 307)
- 6. Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements or hearing impairment you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested, if possible, to arrange for an agent to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please let the organiser know.
- 7. General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), Please note that when you enter competitions run by Jolly Archers the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Year of Birth / Age Grouping, Email, Address, Phone number, Club, County, Region, Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
- 8. In line with the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anybody wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival and provide proof of identity. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.
- 9. Liability Although every reasonable attempt will be made to ensure archers have an enjoyable visit to our venue, Jolly Archers cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained whilst competing in or attending this event. Archery GB insurance cover is in place.
- 10. Age Groups 50+ Men*, 50+ Women*, Men, Women, U18 Men (includes U16 to U18 Men), U18 Women (includes U16 to U18 Women), U15 Men (includes U12 to U15 Men) and U15 Women (includes U12 to U15 Women).

* Please note that if the numbers of 50+ archers in a particular bow style reduces the numbers in the (Senior) Men and (Senior) Women age groups so that they are not sufficiently competitive, the organiser reserves the right to re-classify to 50+ entrants as Seniors.

- 11. Please note that Judges will now inspect archers' equipment at all UK record status events.
- 12. Animals, other than assistance animals such as guide dogs, are not permitted in the venue. Please let the Tournament Organiser know if an assistance animal will accompany the archer.
- 13. Soft soled shoes must be worn in the sports hall.
- 14. Food and drink may not be consumed in the sports hall. (Food and drink will be available in the recreation centre café from 10.00)
- 15. Smoking is not allowed in the recreation centre.
- 16. Ample parking is available.
